Collaborative Problem Solving Groups:

- provides a concrete product that can be shared
- proposals should include the focus, intended product, and plan for structuring the discussion

School-wide Innovations Roundtable:

- presentation on an effective school-wide practice/structure told from the perspective of a school leader and faculty member
- proposals should describe the effective practice/structure to be presented, information about why it is needed, a plan for how participants will be taught, and expected outcomes for participants.
